The number of people registering as unemployed and available for regular employment in Guernsey is 490 which represents 1.52% of the working population. This figure includes 25 people who were placed on the Community and Environmental Project Scheme, 4 on Kickstart and 10 on Karabiner. Of the 451 remaining, 108 were in part-time or casual employment during this week. The number of people registering this time last year was 434 and the number for last month was 506.
